What is happening at Pre-school in Term 2?

Welcome back to Pre-school, we hope you all had a lovely break.

This term our themes will include Homes & Buildings, Bonfire Night, Remembrance Day, Fairy Stories & Christmas.

We have reached that time of year again when the children are going to inevitably catch colds. They may say they want to come to Pre-school but please consider the other children and staff. You need to make the decision if they should come to Pre-school when perhaps a day or two at home would be best to avoid spreading it to others, including the staff. If they are running on Calpol they should not be at Pre-school. Regarding Covid, we will be following the school guidance which is, if the children test positive, they should remain at home for 3 days or longer if they have a temperature. Also, our policy for sickness/diarrhoea is that there must be a period of 48 hours since the last bout before returning to Pre-school.

The staff will be arranging a time for you to come and spend a short time one morning at Pre-school to see what your child enjoys doing. There will also be an opportunity to look at their "learning journey" and talk to their Key Person. More details nearer the time.

CHRISTMAS POST BOX – This will be available from **Thursday 1**st – **Tuesday 13**th **December** for the children to send cards to their friends at Pre-school if they would like too.

SANTA'S SLEIGH - Santa will be touring the village on his sleigh on **Sunday 11th December from 5.00-8.00pm**

CHRISTMAS PARTY – Wednesday 14th December – 12-1.30 pm at Pre-school – All Preschool children are invited to the party where lunch and entertainment will be provided. The Pre-school sessions before and after the party will run as normal.

- If your child attends all day please bring them as usual at 9 am and collect at 3pm, but no packed lunch is required.
- If they normally attend just in the morning, please collect them at 1.30 pm.
- If they attend in the afternoon, please bring them at 12.00 but without a packed lunch.
- If they do not normally come on a Wednesday but would like to come to the party, please bring them at 12.00 and collect at 1.30.

CHRISTMAS ENTERTAINMENT – Monday 19th December 2.30 pm - You are invited to come to Pre-school and watch the children entertain you. All children will be taking part but please let us know if they are unable to attend.

Closure due to Snow — As I write this with temperatures in the high teens, I hope we will not have to think about this yet but just thought I would share with you our policy should the need arise!! Due to the difficulties many have encountered in the past, pushing buggies up the hill, walking with babies in back packs etc we have decided to make our own decisions as to whether it would be safer to close Preschool rather than follow the Primary School's decision. Should we decide to close Preschool, we will announce our decision on our website, Facebook page, and also email our decision to you. We will always consider the safety of our children, parents, and staff.

Safeguarding – At Pre-school we take this very seriously and stress that it is everyone's responsibility. There is a notice on the board by our gate with information but please speak to a member of staff if you have any concerns.

Online safety - we all need to be very aware of on-line safety and ensure that our children are safe whilst using the internet.
